- 2 OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 3 ESTABLISH A PROGRAM OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE TESTING AS A CONDITION OF
- 4 ELIGIBILITY FOR FAMILY INDEPENDENCE PROGRAM ASSISTANCE BENEFITS
- 5 UNDER THIS ACT. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE APPLICANTS FOR FAMILY
- INDEPENDENCE PROGRAM ASSISTANCE BENEFITS TO SUBMIT TO SUBSTANCE
 - ABUSE TESTING BEFORE A FINAL DETERMINATION OF ELIGIBILITY.
- 8 (2) IF AN APPLICANT TESTS POSITIVE FOR SUBSTANCE ABUSE, THE
- 9 APPLICANT IS INELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE FAMILY INDEPENDENCE PROGRAM

- 2 TESTING, THE APPLICANT IS INELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE FAMILY INDEPENDENCE

- 4 (4) IF AN APPLICANT TESTS NEGATIVE FOR SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND
- 5 MEETS ALL THE OTHER ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR FAMILY
- 6 INDEPENDENCE PROGRAM ASSISTANCE BENEFITS, THE COST OF ADMINISTERING
- 7 THE SUBSTANCE ABUSE TEST TO THE APPLICANT SHALL BE DEDUCTED FROM
