

[UBS received \\$800 million in bailout cash](#)

AIG has finally disclosed the names of the banks who received taxpayer funds as "counterparties" to last years' \$170 billion bailout and \$85 billion loan from the Federal Reserve.

According to the report, the troubled Swiss bank UBS received \$800 million. This is almost exactly the amount - \$780 million - UBS had to pay as a fine to the IRS for encouraging US clients to evade tax.
