



DDOT ANNOUNCES SERVICE CHANGES TO BEGIN SEPT. 29th

The Detroit Department of Transportation (DDOT) will implement Weekday and Saturday schedule service changes effective Saturday, September 29, 2012. Service changes are based on transit demands and designed to improve travel-time efficiencies for customer usage. The following routes will be affected by these adjustments:

WEEKDAY SERVICE CHANGES

#14 Crosstown

The time period between buses will increase from 20 minutes to 30 minutes between the hours of 5 p.m. to 6 p.m.

#16 Dexter

The new downtown bus service will be relocated to Griswold at Jefferson at the beginning and ending of route.

#17 Eight Mile

Bus service between the hours of 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. will decrease from 30 minutes to 25 minutes. The time period between buses will decrease from 40 minutes to 35 minutes between the hours of 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

#18 Fenkell

Bus service will now begin and end at the Rosa Parks Transit Center Bay 15. All service to Griswold/Jefferson is discontinued.

#19 Fort

Bus service is combined with Route #25 Jefferson. Route #19 Fort will now be known as Route #25 Jefferson/Fort.

#22 Greenfield

The time period between buses will decrease from 30 minutes to 23 minutes from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

#23 Hamilton

Bus service will now begin and end at the Rosa Parks Transit Center Bay 14. All service to Beaubien/Jefferson is discontinued. The time period between buses will increase from 25 minutes to 30 minutes between the hours of 4:30 p.m. to 6:15 p.m.

#25 Jefferson/Fort

Bus service is combined with Route #19 Fort. The Jefferson Ave. time period between the hours of 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. has increased from 20 minutes to 30 minutes. The Fort St. time period between the hours of 2 p.m. and 6 p.m. has decreased from 30 minutes to 20 minutes

#37 Michigan

The time period between buses will increase from 30 minutes to 60 minutes between the hours of 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.

SATURDAY SERVICE CHANGE

#16 Dexter

A 12 a.m. northbound trip from the Rosa Parks Transit Center has been added.
