**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION TO  
REOPEN CASE AND FILE FIRST AMENDED COMPLAINT [DOC. 32]**

On August 22, 2013, this court entered an order staying the pending case pursuant to the Bankruptcy Court's July 25, 2013 Extension Order. The court held that if the bankruptcy stay is removed, or a party obtains relief from the stay, then the case may be reopened upon the motion of any party. The plaintiffs filed a motion for relief from the stay in the Bankruptcy Court, which was granted, conditioned on plaintiffs amending their complaint as represented. The Bankruptcy Court then reiterated its holding that the case is not subject to the July 25, 2013 Extension order in a November 6, 2013 Order of Clarification, as well as in a December 20, 2013 Order Denying Reconsideration. Now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-captioned case is RE-OPENED.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiffs may file their Proposed First Amended Complaint, which is attached as an exhibit to their motion.
