## **ORDER ADJOURNING TRIAL**

On September 30, 2015, the Court held a final pretrial conference and a hearing on the defendants' motion to strike certain witnesses and exhibits. At the end of the hearing, the Court granted in part the defendants' motion. The Court found that the plaintiff's late disclosure of four witnesses was substantially justified, but the Court also found that, in order to prevent any prejudice to the defendants, it was necessary to allow the defendants the time reasonably needed to depose those late disclosed witnesses, if they so desired. Based on information furnished by the parties, the Court finds that between two and four weeks is a reasonable time to complete those depositions. The Court therefore will adjourn the trial and final pretrial deadlines.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the jury trial in this matter shall begin **on November 3**, **2015 at 8:30 a.m.**
