**2 BY THE EMERGENCY FINANCIAL MANAGER.** 

**3 (C) REVIEW ALL CONTRACTS ENTERED INTO BY THE EMERGENCY 4 FINANCIAL MANAGER, THE CONTRACTING PRACTICES OF THE EMERGENCY** 

5 FINANCIAL MANAGER, AND ALL OTHER DECISIONS OF AND ACTIONS TAKEN BY

6 THE EMERGENCY FINANCIAL MANAGER OR HIS OR HER STAFF.

7 (D) REVIEW ALL WRITTEN PLANS AND REPORTS DEVELOPED BY THE 8 EMERGENCY FINANCIAL MANAGER.

9 (6) THE EMERGENCY FINANCIAL MANAGER'S POWERS AND DUTIES UNDER 10 SECTIONS 39 TO 41A ARE SUBJECT TO OVERSIGHT BY THE EDUCATION 11 FINANCIAL EMERGENCY RESOLUTION BOARD UNDER THIS SECTION.00567'11) of the 96th Legislature is enacted into law.
